

Donor Bill of Rights

I.

You have the right to be informed of the Baptist Home's mission, the way we intend to use donated resources, and our capacity to use donations effectively for their intended purposes.

II.

You have the right to be informed of the identity of those serving on our Board of Directors, and to expect the board to exercise prudent judgment in its stewardship responsibilities.

III.

You have the right to access to our most recent financial statements.

IV.

You have the right to be assured that your gifts will be used for the purposes for which you gave them.

V.

You have the right to receive appropriate acknowledgement and recognition.

VI.

You have the right to be assured that information about your donations is handled with respect and with confidentiality to the extent provided by law.

VII.

You have the right to expect that all relationships with individuals representing organizations of interest to you will be professional in nature.

VIII.

You have the right to be informed whether those seeking donations are volunteers, employees of the Baptist Home or hired solicitors.

IX.

You have the right to know that we do not share our mailing list with other organizations.

X.

You have the right to ask questions when making a donation and to receive prompt, truthful and forthright answers.
